
The Chief Guest was escorted to the venue for the formal proceedings. To create a serene and inviting

Introduction of Houses and Clubs


A vibrant and meaningful assembly was held on 6th May, 2025 by students

Development Goal Club, each offering unique avenues for creative, intellectual, and personal development.



A Clay Moulding Exploration of Teeth Grade IV




